The majority of respondents are in favor of joining the EU, main motivation of which is economic prosperity. The main reasons of the EU opponents are the fear of losing traditions and the deterioration of relations with Russia.

Most of the respondents want Georgia to join NATO for security reasons, but many think that territorial integrity issues make this difficult.

Most people think that disinformation is a significant problem in Georgia today, but they do not know how it is created and spread, nor can they verify it 1

Research results



The majority of the population believes that the best way to preserve traditions and values is to integrate with the West. At the same time, 20% of the population think that traditions will be better preserved if Georgia partners with Russia

Most of the respondents remember the Soviet Union with nostalgia, but at the same time acknowledge it had its flaws. Similarly, most are proud of Stalin, but admit that he was a tyrant, responsible for the deaths of many innocent people





The majority of population thinks they come across disinformation frequently and that they cannot identify it




A large portion of the population says they would not verify the allegedly false information




Thinking about the past month, on average, how often have you accessed the following media platforms?






Russian and Pro-Russian TV channels are the least popular

How often do you watch the following TV channels?




How much do you trust or distrust each station for news and information about current events.






In total, 30% of the population watches at least I pro-Russian channel every week






The segment of population that watches pro-Russian channels every week are more interested in news

Consumption of social media and instant messaging applications – at least once a week





Willingness to join the EU according to the demographic characteristics of the population





Better economic conditions are the main motivation for the population to join the EU






The 13% of the population opposes EU membership mainly because of fear of losing traditions and independence








Most people think that the West is the best partner for Georgia






The West vs Russia - by demographic characteristics of the population








Public opinion is divided on what the state rhetoric towards Russia should be






Although the majority of the population wants to join NATO, a large part sees the problem of territorial integrity as a hindering factor






One third of the population is vulnerable to anti-US disinformation narratives





The majority of the population is vulnerable to anti-Turkish disinformation messages






Soviet Union legacy



Most Georgians positively assess the Soviet period and believe that they were looked after better than today







Please tell me how much you agree or disagree with the following statement: People like me had better opportunities in the west than in the Soviet Union








Assessment of Stalin legacy according to demographic characteristics









There are different opinions regarding the **direction in which Georgia is going.** Which one do you agree with? Georgia is...






A large part of the population thinks that political parties do not represent their interests properly and elections are not held fairly






Majority of the population blames the problems on 'Georgian Dream' more than 'United National Movement'


Religiosity
